Presentation – Monday, 29 May 2017.

Thank you your honour.

Today, I am representing myself and I am the applicant in this case.

My presentation here today is to apply to have the interlock condition on my licence removed.

I am making this presentation to cover 3 separate subjects.

The licence eligibility report dated 22 May 2017, issued by the A.D.D.S.A. has been submitted to the Court. I believe that it was emailed last Friday.

Has your honour the report in his possession? (Wait until his honour confirms)

I quote from this report, part of the final paragraph on Page 2:-

“There would not appear to be any impediment to his licence restoration from an alcohol related perspective.”

I now move along to the time spent off the road from 17 December 2015.

I have made no arrangements to have an interlock fitted, following the Case heard on 1 May 2017, as the time span of the interlock condition has been served.

Lastly, I move along to the subject of the risk of me re-offending.

On or about the 18th November 2016, I received a valid Victorian Drivers Licence from VIC ROADS, with an interlock condition.

This followed an offer to renew, received prior.

Your honour, I am of the understanding that my licence had been suspended since 17 December 2015.

This matter was determined by Magistrate, Palmer on 1 May 2017.

Effectively, the interlock condition has been in effect since 18 November 2013, for a period of 2 years.

This period clearly has now expired and I have made no arrangements to have an interlock refitted.

Accordingly, my application is supported by this.

Let me review the key subjects covered.

- (1) The report from A.D.D.S.A. in all aspects supports my application that I no longer should be required to have an interlock.
- (2) I have detailed the circumstances as to why I have not had an interlock fitted.
- (3) I have demonstrated that I have no propensity to re-offend.

Therefore, your honour, I ask you to take into consideration the information that I have presented to you today in coming to a favourable determination to remove the interlock condition on my driver's licence.
